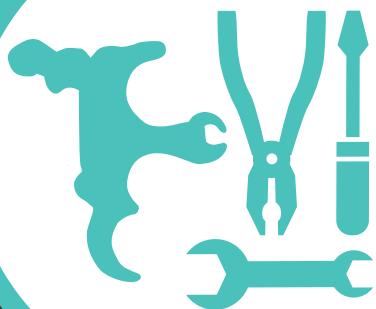
This practical workshop prepares coaches and club volunteers to support disabled people who are new to archery.
