Event Format	All Senior Compound, Recurve & junior compound archers U21,U18 & U16, archers will shoot on an individual vertical 3-spot 40cm face All Longbow, Barebow & junior compound archers U15, U14 & U12, will shoot on a 40cm full face 3 arrows in 2 minutes. Event run as per WA rules at the time of the event. All bosses will be layered foam. Duel scoring applies & PDAs maybe be used for scoring	
Awards	SCAS Regional Champion. Single Round only; Trophies will be awarded to the highest placed archers. Women, men, junior women and junior men per bow style per age group. Medals for the minor according to number of entries. <b>SCAS County Team awards</b> -Team of 4 Recurve, team of 2 archers for Compound, Barebow & Longbow. A County team can be nominated by the County Team Manager or will be the top placed archers on the day by the TO. All awards will be taken from the first score (should you shoot a second session) Visitor medals depending on number of entries.
