Titles and Records

5.5 Confirmation of World Records

5.5.1 World Records shot at Olympic and Paralympic Games, World Championships and World Ranking Events are confirmed automatically as soon as the scores are official. Records shot at other tournaments complying with [Article 4.8.2.](#) are subject to confirmation by the Secretary General.

5.5.1.3 Should a World Record be broken by two or more equal scores made on the same day, the athletes shall be declared joint World Record holders.

For Mixed Team 70m Round. If two athletes of the same gender shoot the same score, the athlete having a higher number of 10's and/or X's will be the record holder. In case the two have the same number of 10's and X's they will be joint record holder with the athlete from the other gender.

5.5.1.3 Should a World Record be broken by two or more equal scores made on the same day, the athletes shall be declared joint World Record holders.

For Mixed Team Round. If two athletes of the same gender shoot the same Qualification Round score, the athlete having a higher number of 10's and/or X's will be the record holder. In case the two have the same number of 10's and X's they will be joint record holder with the athlete from the other gender.

For Men or Women Teams at events where four archers from the same country compete in the Qualification Round in one category, if the third and fourth ranked archers in the team shoot the same Qualification Round score, the athlete having a higher number of 10's and/or X's will be the record holder. In case the two have the same number of 10's and X's, they will be joint record holders with the other two archers in their team.
