

INTERPRETATIONS

WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

BOOK 3 – Appendix 2, Article 3.3

Archery Austria has requested an interpretation with respect to the following questions:

1] Is the stool as shown in the pictures* allowed for an para-athlete ("stool" is noted on the classification card)?

Measurements of the stool on the ground: back 47 cm, front 40 cm, width on the shooting line 55 cm

Hight of the front-plate: 0.5 cm



2] Is the para-athlete allowed to put her/his feet or a part of her/his feet on the front-plate during shooting to prevent the stool from tipping over?

The Constitution and Rules Committee finds the question presented to be within the terms of reference of the Para-Archery Committee.

The Constitution and Rules Committee has determined that the following interpretation is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

The following is the decision of the Para-Archery Committee:

- 1) This is a stool and fulfills the character of a stool
- 2) the contact of the feet to the front plate appears to provide no advantage to the archer.

Therefore, our interpretation is that this is a legal piece of equipment.
