In order to improve how we manage our archery facilities around the country, we have are to introduce a new system for archery range registration and assessment.

Part of this process will involve site visits to archery ranges that require a 'ground dispensation'. We require a network of ground assessors to perform this function.

This role would involve travelling to locations within a region and assessing a ground to ensure it meets the Rules of Shooting, Health and Safety criteria and functional performance criteria. Site visits would be arranged on an ad-hoc basis by agreement with the assessor.

You would receive some training to support you in this role alongside expenses and a small fee for each visit.
