Deaf Awareness Tips Safety Information

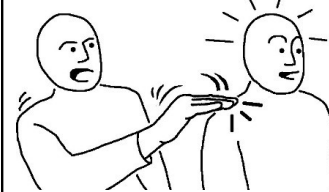

Important to remember when shouting 'FAST' Deaf archer will not hear you. Touch and hold on the Deaf archer's shoulder until they respond or tapping on the shoulder or by waving are other ways



Touch and hold the Deaf archer's shoulder. Say (STOP). Make sure they look at you to show they have understood.



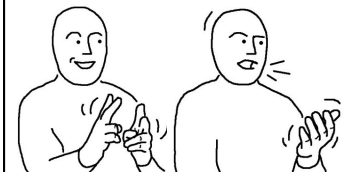
You can get the Deaf archer's attention by tapping on their shoulder



Judge / Field Captain / or responsible person can / must 'wave' to alert the Deaf archer to the urgent command to STOP.



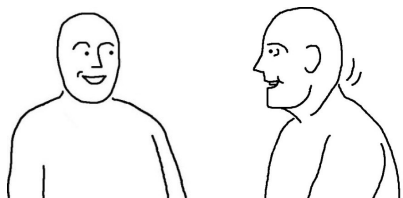
To ask the Deaf archer to stop or wait use the natural gesture for stop (an open hand)



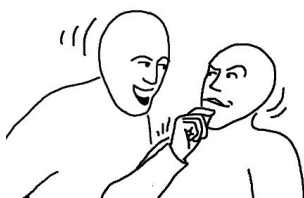
Please ensure that an sign language interpreter or a competent signer is available to translate the rules for the Sign language user Deaf archer.

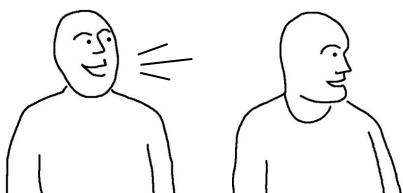

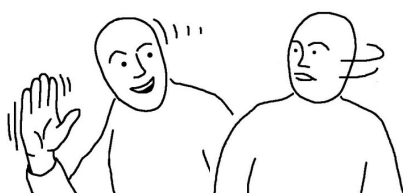
Always get the Deaf archer's attention first and look at archer when talking.



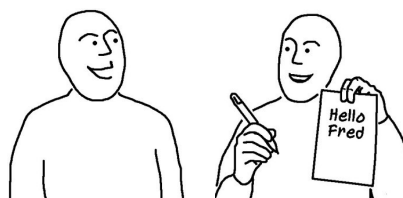
Don't shout . Talk in a normal manner to a Deaf archer. Don't get too close.



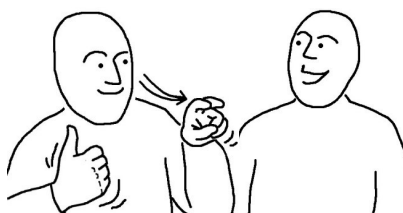
Don't shout ! They make sure you are facing a Deaf archer when speaking



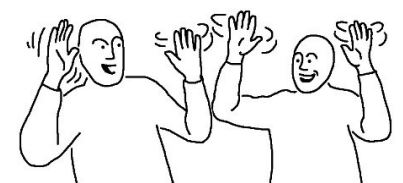
Be prepared to wave to a Deaf archer to get their attention.



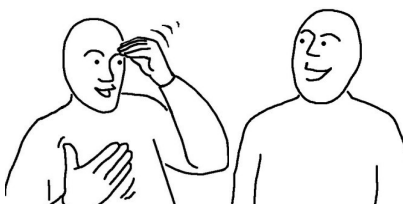
If you are stuck -write it down



Use natural gestures



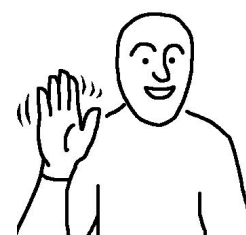
A Deaf archer can not hear applause so clap by waving your hands up in the air. This is the visual way to clap.



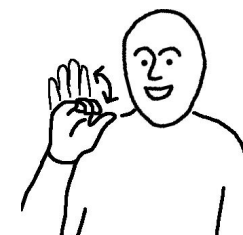
