

INTERPRETATIONS

WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

Book 3, Chapter 11.1.3

A question was raised by the Icelandic Archery Committee if the rest pictured below is legal in the Recurve Division.

The Constitution and Rules Committee finds the question presented to be within terms of reference of the Technical Committee. The Constitution and Rules Committee has determined that the following interpretation of the Technical Committee is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

Response from the Technical Committee:

It is the unanimous decision of the Technical Committee that the arrow rest presented by the Icelandic Archery Committee is legal in the recurve and bare bow divisions.

Rule 11.1.3 (22.3.3 for Bare Bow) An arrow rest which can be adjustable.

Under this rule, any arrow rest is legal in the Recurve and Bare Bow divisions as long as it is within 4 cm (2 cm for Bare Bow) inside of the pivot point of the grip, does not offer an additional aid in aiming and is not electric or electronic.
