WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

Book 4, Article 22.3.6.2

World Archery Argentina has requested an interpretation as to whether the weight shown below is allowed in the Barebow Division.

The Constitution and Rules Committee (“C&R”) finds the question presented to be within the terms of reference of the Technical Committee after consultation with the Field and 3D Archery Committee.

C&R has determined that the following interpretation is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

Response from the Technical Committee:

It is the majority decision of the Technical Committee that the weight connection device shown in the photo below is not legal in the Barebow Division under Rule 22.3.6.2, which states, “Weight(s) may be added to the lower part of the riser. All weights, regardless of shape, shall mount directly to the riser without rods, extensions, angular mounting connections or shock-absorbing devices”. The Technical Committee has determined that the weights are attachment to an extension and angular mounting connection and are not attached directly to the riser as is required under the rule.
