1) Judge Changes and news Sadly we lost two of our team recently.

Peter Turner from Hampshire passed away on November 8th, Peter was such a lovely kind man and he gave so much to archery. Not just through his judging but also with supporting and promoting Field, 3D and Flight and through his beloved Overton Black Arrows club. Peter had been a Judge for nearly 55 years, he will be greatly missed by everyone who knew him and will be fondly remembered for many many years to come.

Derrick Lovell MBE also passed away at the beginning of November. Derrick retired from active judging in 2021 after 45 years as a Judge. He achieved the level of International Judge and was Chair of Judges at the Sydney Olympics in 2000. Derrick will be forever remembered for his passion for archery, in particular Field archery. Derrick's legacy will live on through the many judge he helped train. Derrick was unfailingly kind, generous with his time and knowledge, had a wicked sense of humour and the sort of Judge we all hope to be.

Our thoughts and prayers are with Peter and Derrick's families at this sad time.

We have also had some retirements. Andy Turner from Berkshire has decided to retire. Andy has been a Judge since 2008 and his calm presence on the field will be missed. I would like to thank Andy for his tireless work and professionalism over his career. He will be missed by Judges, archers and organisers alike.

3) Compound reminders

Just a few gentle reminders for compound bow inspections.

There is no limit on the length of compound sight tunnels or hoods. The 2cm limit only applies to Recurve bows.

Multi sight pins are allowed for compounds at target events, including indoors. Compounds are allowed bits on their string in order to assist with keeping the peep sight safely attached and aligned, there is no limit to the number or location of such items.
