Please find below a few bits of information to keep you up to date with the latest news.

#### 1) Judge Changes and news

#### 2) Judge Uniform

Just a reminder that the following trousers are all allowable as part of the Judging Uniform

- i) Kudos – the trousers from the current uniform supplier
- ii) Henbury Chinos in Stone
- iii) ProJob – Cargo Workwear in Stone
- iv) Craghoppers – KIWI PRO in Stone
- v) 5.11 – TDU TacLite Pants in Stone
- vi) Regatta – Action Trousers in Stone
- vii) WA or WAE uniform trousers

#### 3) Electronic Devices at Tournaments

Archers are allowed to have electronic devices with them at Target tournaments as long as they are not being used as communication devices – PLEASE NOTE that the rules for Field and 3D are different.

So electronic devices such as Kindles, E-Books, Tablets, PDAs and Phones are allowed as long as they are not being used as a communication device. For example, phones can be used to record scores, PDAs can be used as an official scoresheet and E-books can be read (particularly in the case of archers who remain on the shooting line, providing it does not disturb any other archer who is shooting).
