Please find below a few bits of information to keep you up to date with the latest news.

1) Judge Changes and news

2) Seminars

There will be in-person Seminars for Candidate to County and County to Regional at Lilleshall on Saturday 26 October.

The Seminars will include the written part of the assessments.

You can sign up for the Seminars on Sport:80 and don't forget that if you are attending an in-person Seminar you may be entitled to a grant from SCAS.

3) National Assessments

If anyone would like to do their National assessment in 2025 needs to complete the J03 and send it to me by the end of September. They will also need to be available for their practical assessment during 2025 and the written assessment will take place at the end of October 2025.

7) Sight Tunnel

Just to make you aware there is a new sight tunnel on the market manufactured by Shrewd. The tunnel is in several pieces, with the two pieces together the tunnel is 2.5cm long, and so illegal. Once the front section is unscrewed and removed the tunnel is 2cm long so legal. Please make sure you check the length of the sight tunnels on recurves. See photos below

11) Update on Decut Target Faces for WRS Events

World Archery have issued the following statement on Decut faces

“Temporary suspension of Decut certification has been lifted following the submission of a new batch of target faces bearing licence number #18, which comply with World Archery regulations.

Use of Decut #18 target faces is now authorised for all events on the World Archery calendar, but those bearing licence #10 remain banned.”

So if you are judging a WRS event with Decut faces please check the licence number carefully.
