


Two arrows shot out of time

Indoor Scoring

Remember – for 3 spot face scoring, the following applies:

1. Determine the value of each arrow

2. Determine the number of arrows shot

3. Deal with any arrows shot out of time

Scoring – Single Faces

- Indoors, we could shoot Portsmouth or WA rounds on single faces:
- Remember to determine how many arrows have been shot (should have been shot)
- Deal with any arrows shot out of time
- You could have a different score than if you were shooting on a 3 face spot

Worcester Round

5 arrow ends

- 5 scoring zones score 1-5
- If using a 5 spot face, same applies as 3 spot shooting if more than one arrow in a face
- After 30 arrows, archers CD will shoot on the top faces, and AB on the bottom faces. Top faces always shoot first

Vegas Round

- AGB Vegas is not the same as the "Vegas in Vegas".
- 3 spot face, triangular, with target faces numbered 1,2,3
- Arrows numbered consecutively, and shot in consecutive order in faces 1,2,3 in order.
- Only score a value if correct arrow in correct face
- Compounds use inner 10
